Event Schedule: The event schedule will be sent to all coaches no later than one week before the competition. Please check with your coach for your competition time.

We would like to have all events on Saturday March 20th, but please plan for this competition to be a two day event if we receive a high number of applications.

Competition Standards: The St. Patrick's Day Open will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth in the current ISI test standards, ISI competition handbook and the current ISI Recreational Ice Skater Team Competition Standards with revisions effective Jan. 1, 2010.

Registration: The registration table will be open throughout the competition. Skaters should arrive at least one hour prior to their scheduled event, check in at the registration table, and pick up their competition information packet.

Music: Music must be turned in at the registration table. All music must be recorded on **cds** and labeled with the competitor's name, team name, event, and age group on the side that is to be played. **We cannot play cassettes.** Cd's must contain 1 track per cd only. We strongly suggest having a back-up version of your competition music.

Judges: Judges for the competition are Associate Member of the ISI. A MANDATORY Judge's meeting will take place 30 minutes prior to the start of the first event. There must be one representative from each team at the meeting. One additional judges meeting will be held before the afternoon events. Exact time to be determined by the final schedule. **Only certified ISI judges that attend at least one of the judges meetings will be allowed to judge.** Judges inquiry forms must be completed and received along with the team's registration forms. Skaters representing a rink that does not provide judges may not be allowed to participate.

Awards: Medals will be awarded for the first 5 places in each event. Award ceremonies will be held every hour on the hour.

Practice Ice: Practice will be available the morning of the competition. 30-minute sessions will be offered starting at 6:30am for \$10.00. Space is limited, so please register in advance if you would like practice ice. Email Lindsay Tilley at ltalley@icepark.com to register.

T-Shirts: A limited number of t-shirts will be available for purchase at the competition.

Team Points raised for all ISI Competitions are as follow:

Group Events: Production and Synchronized Teams

The following group event entries will receive

1. First Place 25 points
2. Second Place 20 points
3. Third Place 15 points
4. Fourth Place 10 points
5. Fifth Place 5 points

Plus 5 Participation Points per team event entry.

All Individual & Partner events receive 1 Participation Point, plus the appropriate placement points.

Supplying Qualified Judges for ISI Competitions

-All judges must be current Professional Member and must be certified. The certification exams are given each year at district seminar and at ISI National Events. Certification can also be done online at [www, skateisi.org](http://www.skateisi.org).

- All judges must make themselves available to judge during the competition. By competition time, students are prepared to perform without additional coaching.

Please note the required hours of judging per team:

11-21	2	2 hours each
22-32	3	2 hours each
33-44	4	2 hours each
45-55	5	2 hours each
56-66	6	2 hours each

Individual Compulsories

Skaters will have a 1 minute time limit

All skaters will perform the compulsories listed for their level in any order. Additional maneuvers, such as any jump, spin, or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured move, are not allowed. Performance should meet the specifications of the test level. No music will be used for this event. A minimum numbers of connecting steps should be used.

FS1 (1/2 ice) – two foot spin, backward outside edges, waltz jump

FS 2 (1/2 ice) - FS 2 dance step, one-foot spin, ½ lutz

FS 3 (1/2 Ice) - FS 3 dance step, toe loop, change foot spin

FS 4 (full ice)- FS 4 dance step, loop, sit spin

FS 5 (full ice)- FS 5 dance step, axel, camel spin

FS 6 (full ice)- FS 6 dance step, double salchow, spin combination

FS 7(full ice) – FS 7 dance step, double toe jump, flying camel

FS 8 (full ice)- FS 8 dance step (circular), double loop, illusion

FS 9 (full ice) – FS 9 dance step (straight line), jump combination: three jumps performed in exact sequence. Arabesque/Bauer/Spread Eagle sequence.

FS 10 (full ice)– FS 10 dance step (creative), triple edge jump, three Arabia cartwheels or butterfly jumps (choice of one)

Solo and Partnering Compulsory Dance

Dance: Skaters will do two patterns of each dance listed for their level.

New for 2009 – 2010 Season

This year District IV is starting a new Team Point Tournament designed to increase skater participation at local competitions. Most teams in the area attend the same events every season and rarely try a “new” event. With more rinks joining ISI and hosting competitions it would be beneficial to all of us if our skaters attended more competitions. These skaters will return to their home rinks with pictures, medals and fun stories to share about their experience at a new competition.

The tournament will start with the first competition of the season and will end at the District Champs in Prince William on April 18. A District Trophy will be awarded to the team with the most points at the end of the season. (I know some of our member facilities plan events after the District Champs, these events will be the starting events for the 2010-2011 season.)

Each facility that hosts an ISI endorsed competition will designate one event as a tournament event. This event can be any individual event: Freestyle, Tots- Delta, Spotlights, Footwork, Artistic or Rhythmic. Each rink must choose a different event.
