## Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What should my child wear to Skating School Classes?

A: We highly recommend that all students wear warm clothing and gloves. Skaters will be learning how to fall and get up properly and will need gloves to keep warm. It is not a requirement, but we do recommend helmets as well. Helmets can be checked out at our front desk. A bike helmet from home will work too.

Q: What if we miss a class?

A: We do not offer any specific make-up day for classes missed, but since we have another day of skating school we ask that you make up your class on that different day. Be sure to let the front desk know that you are making up a class when you arrive.

Q: Will my child progress to a different level after 6 weeks of classes?

A: Every skater will learn at a different level and will therefore progress at a different pace. Rather than conducting formal evaluations that might make each skater uncomfortable or nervous, your instructor will evaluate and move your child when they feel as though they are ready. This may occur during a 6 week session.

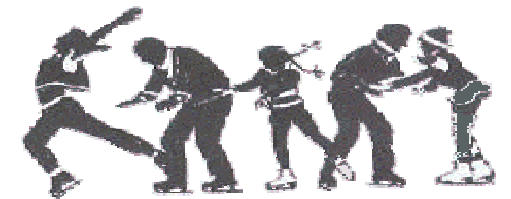

## Class Descriptions

**Tots- (Ages 3-5)** will introduce the basics of ice skating with emphasis on safety and fun. Skaters will learn how to fall down and get up properly as well as skating forward and beginning backward skating.

**Beginning Skating 1**—This class is designed for any skater ages 6 to 14 who has never skated or who has very little skating experience. This is the most basic beginning class the Ice Park offers.

**Beginning and Intermediate Adult**—(Ages 15 and Up) will follow the same curriculum as Beginning 1 and 2 or Alpha but will allow students to learn in an Adult only environment. Skaters will feel relaxed and the class will follow each skater's individual pace.

**Pre-Alpha**—This class will go a step further from beginning skating and will teach skaters how to glide on one foot, swizzle forward and backwards, and snowplow stopping. **Beginning Skating is a pre-requisite.**

**Alpha/Beta**—In Alpha, skaters will learn forward crossovers, proper forward skating, and one foot snowplow stops. In Beta, skaters will learn backward crossovers, backward skating, and T-stops. Additional elements in higher levels will be introduced as well.

**Pre-Alpha is a pre-requisite.**

**Gamma/Delta**— Skaters will learn mohawks, 3-turns, and edges in these levels. Pre-Freestyle elements such as hopping, lunging, and spinning will be introduced as well. **Beta is a pre-requisite.**

**Freestyle Jump/Spin**—Designed for freestyle skaters to work on elements in their particular level of skating. Skaters will also be introduced other elements of skating such as footwork moves.
